

## **January 20th Facilitator Training**

The Center for Community Stewardship (C4CS) is excited to announce that they are collaborating with the Frank Zeidler Center for Public Discussion out of Milwaukee to bring a process called Dialogue Circles to the Dane County area. We are launching this collaboration by bringing the Zeidler Center to Madison to train 25 community members to be dialog circle facilitators on January 20th from 9am-4pm at the Fitchburg Public Library. Participants signed up so far include an alder, a police officer, and community members from a variety of communities and backgrounds.

This training is the first step in being able to have a set of community facilitators who will help us host a series of dialogue circles in the Spring of 2018 around challenging topics such as policing, race, and political divides. These facilitators will also allow us to provide facilitation services to community initiatives who would like facilitators at their event.

### The Center for Community Stewardship

C4CS is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that brings people together and facilitates their conversations to develop dreams and realize actions for their community. C4CS currently has two program areas: fiscal sponsorship and community facilitation. **Fiscal Sponsorship** is a formal arrangement in which the Center for Community Stewardship sponsors projects that lack tax-exempt status. We currently provide this service to 26 area projects. **Community Facilitation** services include advising, coaching, facilitation, and training about facilitation and community visioning processes.
